3. Where would the transfer of patient care from EMS be? Will someone meet EMS units with instructions and to guide them through your intake process? Where?

4. Is there a designated area for doffing PPE for prehospital personnel? Where? *This doffing area shall be sheltered from the elements and out of public view. Explain.

5. Is there a designated area where prehospital personnel can begin to decontaminate their vehicle? Explain.

6. Does the hospital have appropriate facilities and policies to dispose of contaminated PPE and medical waste generated by prehospital personnel while treating a patient suspected of infection with Ebola? Explain.

7. Does the hospital have a pre-determined process for notifying MDH regarding prehospital personnel with possible exposure to Ebola during patient care? Explain.

8. Is there a pre-determined process for notifying involved prehospital crews as soon as Ebola is eliminated from the differential diagnosis or of Ebola blood testing results? Explain process.
